#### Where are we now?

Cornwall as a separate economic area qualified for EU structural funding in 1998, poorest part of England

C26,000 VAT registered businesses and C35,000 sole traders and micros operating below £85k pa t/o UK 6<sup>th</sup> worst Productivity in G7. Cornwall's Productivity 72 v UK index of 100. Why and what this means Wages 17% lower than national average – not a good stat for a region presenting ourselves as go-ahead 21st Century business zone

Historic lack of diversity in population and therefore workforce

What impact has 22 years of EU funding had? Universities, Superfast, infrastructure, business confidence

But – tourism, care, agriculture, fishing, retail still large and patchy productivity -> low wages







#### Where do these changes lead us?

- New industries springing up: Renewables, software, createch, healthtech and more – 21<sup>st</sup> Century hero sectors
- Levelling up? Business support, infrastructure, transport, health and social care
- Chamber of Commerce Frameworks: Digital Infrastructure, The Built Environment, Wellbeing in the Workplace, Planet, adding Transport and Inclusivity
- Appointing Sustainability (Planet) champion, Inclusivity champion, Wellbeing champion
- Increased diversity in workforce: Cornwall Pride, Black Voices Cornwall, Surge, West Country Women Awards, Beacon Project
- Pride in Place, civic minded, collaborative
- Climate Emergency, Planet C (incl 200 on Carbon Literacy Training course), Goodfest, Anthropy just the start









## The next six months...

- Short term: energy crisis, inflation, interest rate rise, labour shortage, supply issues, war
- Longer term: Levelling up, Shared Prosperity Fund, Cornwall's new sectors
- Lobbying new PM we need the right sort of business support
